**SMALL
WORKS
EXHIBIT**

The October show in the Ethel Smith & Members' Galleries will feature "small works" only.

Small works are defined as small supports that measures 11" x 14" or whose surface is **154 sq. in. or less**. This measurement **does not** include the frame.

For example: a small work measuring 7" x 22" has 154 sq. in. of surface area, excluding the frame. These artworks may be framed or gallery wrapped as long as the wrap is 1.5" thick. **There is no minimum measurement requirement**. If we can see it, we can hang it.

This is a departure from our normal gallery policy which does not allow any artwork that is less than 8" x 10" or 80 sq. in. This time we are looking for the "small stuff" only.

Since all of the artworks will be "small works" we will allow everyone to bring two (2) paintings. So, get all of those little gems out and let us feature them in October.

The deadline for registering artworks for the October show is Wednesday, September 22, 2010 at noon.

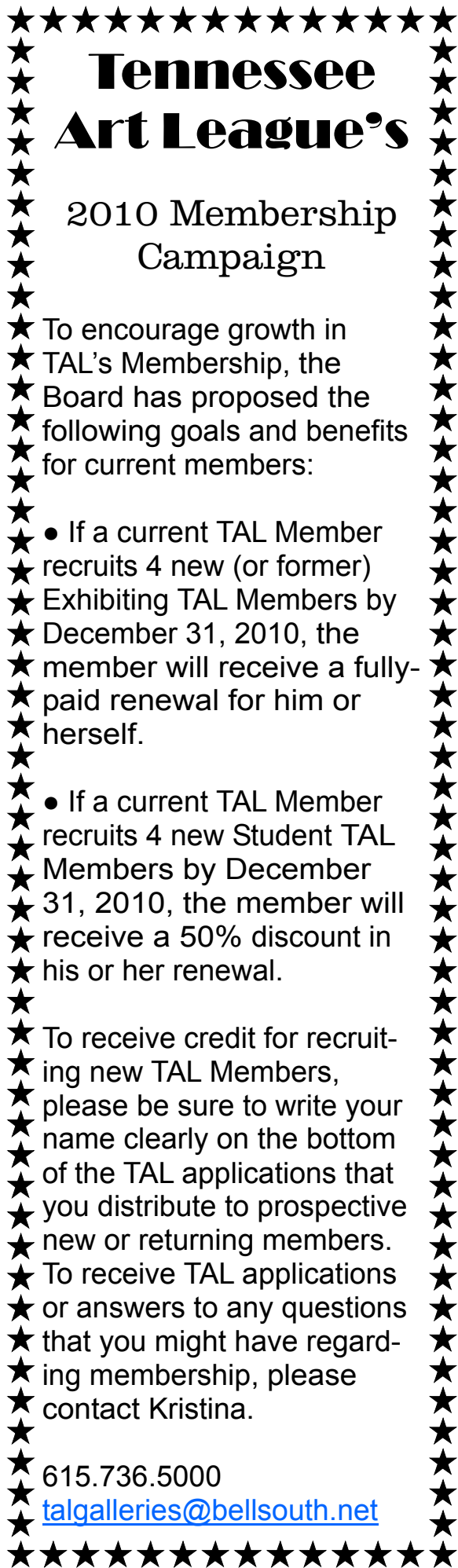
